- Abstract/Full Paper should be typed in Font Style Arial Unicode MS, Title size-14, Test Font Size – 12, Line and Paragraph Spacing - 1.5. <u>In case of Sanskrit, Bengali and</u> <u>Hindi Abstract/Full Paper, Font name should be specified.</u>
- Only selected person will be allowed to present.
- Paper can be presented by one of the authors only. If there is more than one Author, then Presenter must be mentioned clearly.
- Participants will be given 5 minutes for presentation.
- All papers have to be presented live through online platform (The platform link will be shared in email and/or WhatsApp Group before the Webinar). No video recording will be allowed.
- Fair internet speed during presentation is the responsibility of the participant.
- The Co-author can attend the Webinar and if he/she marks attendance for all sessions of the Webinar then will be issued Certificate of Participation only.
