




3. Extent of coverage of syllabus


18. The prescribed books/reading materials are available in the library





- A large number of students given the opinion to make the laboratories better equipped and suggested for proper cleaning and maintaining the toilets and washrooms.
- Some students are not highly satisfied on grievance redressal in time.
