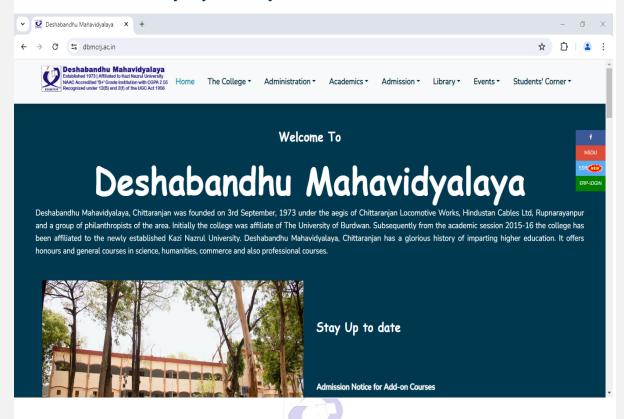
Services and facilities at the library: -

- ➤ The books are issued all the working days throughout the week.
- > The book issue returns services are carried on through the circulation system of koha.
- ➤ The catalogue of books, journals and other documents can be accessed through koha OPAC of the library.
- ➤ OPAC of the library can also be accessed through the mobile. Students can scan the QR code from the library or from the websites of koha OPAC of Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya.
- ➤ The information regarding newly added documents is available in *New Arrivals* in koha.
- > Subscription of NLIST programme for e resources.
- > Students can get e resources according to their syllabus from the database WBCOLOR.
- ➤ Digital resources of scanned copies of books, e books, study materials, questions and syllabuses can be accessed from the institutional repository of the college.
- ➤ There are separate WhatsApp groups for the students for sharing resources and queries regarding the library.
- > Reading room facility is available for students as well as for the faculties.
- ➤ Reading room capacity is 20 persons at a time for students and 10 persons at a time for the faculty members.
- ➤ Computer facility is available for students as well as for staff also.
- ➤ Reprographic facilities are provided for the documents needed for academic purposes only.
- > Students can get a xerox facility at a reasonable rate for the materials not issued for home issues.

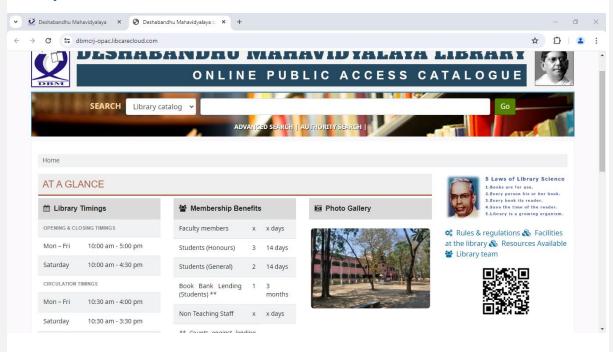

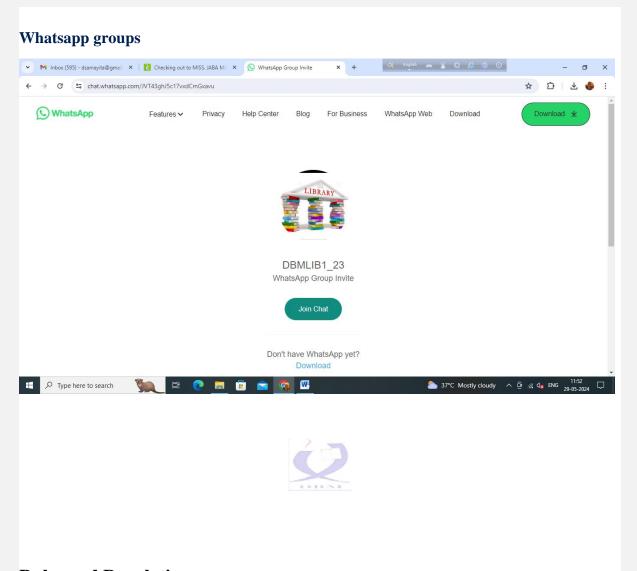






Institutional Repository of Each Department





Rules and Regulations:-

For teaching and non-teaching staff:

- Library remains closed on Sundays and Public Holidays only as per university holiday list.
- All Teaching, Non-teaching staff members and students are the members of the library.
- All teaching staff including Librarian is allowed to lend a maximum of 10 books from the library and for the SACTS the number of 5 books is allowed to lend.
- Renewal is obligatory for holding of books more than 30 days.
- The administrative staff members, library staff, laboratory assistants are allowed to borrow not more than 5 books at a time for 1 month.

For students:

- The students can borrow a maximum of 3 books at a time for 14 days, which can be further renewed for a maximum period of another 14 days.
- Students can be allowed to renew books for a maximum of two times if those books have not been on demand by any other members of the library.

General rules for the students:

- Library issues two cards from the beginning of the session- i. Book borrowing card ii. Reading room card.
- Students will not be allowed without the student identity card / reading room card in the library and the reading room as well.
- Students require signing through the register before entering into the library.
- Book borrowing card is not permitted to the student for taken at home and the reading room card should be transferred at the end of the session.
- Reference books, newspapers, questions, syllabuses or any other library materials issued in the reading room are not permitted to be issued for home loan.
- Fine would be taken for the failure of submission of the book within the book lending period at the rate of 1 Rs for each day and he/she will be not allowed to use the library if the charge exceeds 20 Rs.
- All books should be submitted before the final examination of each year
- Duplicate cards would be issued in the case of missing library cards from the library by charging 2 Rs.
- Students should keep silent and mobile phones should be switched off while using the library.
